SUBJECT: Chrysler Supplier Assessments

Pursuant to the letter dated April 20, 2010, from Daniel C. Knott, Senior VP - Purchasing, you were notified that Chrysler Group LLC contracted Grant Thornton LLP to complete supplier assessments across its entire base. To best streamline your ongoing data submissions, and provide you performance scorecards and benchmarks, Chrysler has adopted our web-based application, Vontik (www.vontik.com).

Vontik brokers the exchange of critical information, provides evaluation and value-added analytic tools, and engages business communication. Vontik's key member features include:

- User-friendly, standardized MS Excel data templates
- Multi-level performance scorecards
- Red/Yellow/Green interpretations of key performance indicators (KPIs)
- Performance benchmarks

As part of the supplier assessment program, Chrysler is requiring all suppliers to register on Vontik and use its web-based interface to submit their data. There is no cost for you to join Vontik and comply with Chrysler's request.

You will receive an invitation via email from Vontik shortly following the receipt of this letter. You are responsible for ensuring that the last four quarters of YTD financial results are entered into Vontik using the template provided in the application. Going forward, your organization is required to upload each subsequent quarter within 45 days of the quarter ending.

Please follow the instructions detailed below to complete your registration and access the latest data templates to begin uploading your four most recent quarter-ending **year-to-date** (YTD) financial results.

1. Go to www.vontik.com.
2. Click on the **Join Today!** button in the Member Sign In box.
3. Follow the step-by-step registration process to complete your login setup, member setup (company account), and user setup. The attached User Guide will help you navigate through this process. Please note: your company may already have an account created in Vontik. Please do not create a new account if one already exists.
4. Read the Getting Started page.
5. Print the complete User Guide as a reference during your introduction to the system. This document is available on the Getting Started page and on the top right corner of every page in the application. This will help you become acclimated with the system's functionality.



6. On the Getting Started page, click the I Received an Invitation link located near the bottom of the page.
7. Enter the 12-digit invitation code you received via an email (from Chrysler's network) into the input field located in the lower right of the screen, then click "Submit"
8. This will take you directly to the Network Name's access profile. Please complete the profile questions and then click the "Update" button at the bottom of the page.
9. You are now an active member of the Network Name and can begin uploading your financial data.

NOTE: If your organization has already registered in Vontik, and you have a user account established, you can simply login to Vontik and follow steps 7 through 9 above. Additionally, Chrysler has elected to use the standard Vontik templates. If you have already uploaded data using these templates, Chrysler will gain access to your historical data after you join their network.

A detailed User Guide is available, via a hyperlink in the upper right corner, once you have completed registration and logged in. Follow the User Guide to help you upload data, view your scorecard, and join additional networks. You should notice that the financial template includes only one period at a time. You must complete one template for each time period. These templates are available in the system, and all future template updates will be provided through the system.
